Understanding and sharing

Do I really understand how Jesus' death and resurrection saves me? Do I need to completely 'get it' for it to 'work'? The answer to these questions is thankfully – no. The saving impact of the life, death and resurrection of Jesus is not dependent on my understanding. It is a mystery that we can never fully comprehend. That is not to say we can't understand it, but rather to say that we will continue to have as many questions as we have answers. We are encouraged to ponder mysteries in our personal prayer and in conversations with each other. Perhaps this week, with family or friends, share your thoughts and/or questions about how the death and resurrection of Jesus 'saves' us. Sometimes we can be afraid of what people will think of us if we don't know the answers to some of these questions, and sometimes we worry what people will think if we do know the answers! As followers of Jesus, however, we must be having these kinds of conversations, conversations about our faith, our beliefs, and our lives. It is often in these conversations that the Spirit of God reveals more of the truth. We find ourselves hearing or saying things that lead us deeper into a place of understanding.

We can take great courage and hope from the readings at Mass this Sunday – in them we find a variety of conversations, either in person or in writing of people making sense of how the death and resurrection of Jesus changes our understanding of everything. I always find great reassurance when the disciples, who had three years full time with Jesus don't understand what's happening. I also take great confidence in seeing the transformation of the disciples from being people who don't understand to becoming great preachers and teachers once they are filled with the Holy Spirit. If I really want to understand the mysteries of my faith, I must first ask the Holy Spirit to fill my heart and my mind, and then trust the prayer and talk with others.
